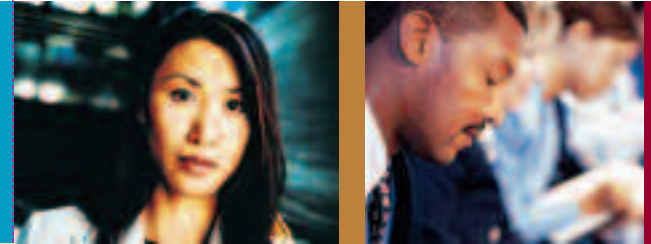

Broaden your expertise

There are immense public health challenges facing our country and our world, making this a compelling time to study public health. The Executive Program in Public Health Practice offers timely, relevant courses in public health. Focus areas include:

- Public Health Leadership
- Food Safety
- Preparedness, Response, and Recovery
- Cultural Competency in Public Health Practice

Students may also design a focus area based on their own area of interest.

The University of Minnesota School of Public Health offers an exciting learning opportunity for health and human services professionals with an advanced degree to broaden their expertise by exploring key areas of public health.

You can earn a Master of Public Health (M.P.H.) degree in as little as 15 months of full-time study, depending on focus area and course load.

The Executive Program is also a venue for you to network with other professionals from a variety of leadership positions throughout the country.



Flexible and focused

The Executive Program is tailored to each student's educational priorities, with an individual focus area and a faculty advisor who has expertise in that particular concentration.

Nearly half of the course credits may be completed at the student's home location (online coursework, Field Experience, and Master's Project), which allows you to continue working while pursuing your degree. Coursework for several of the focus areas is available in a concentrated format during the School of Public Health's three-week Public Health Institute held every spring at the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities.

Course requirements

Executive Program students must complete a total of 42 credits: 24.5 are required core courses, and the remainder are course electives from your chosen focus area. Required core courses are:

- Public Health Practice Seminar
- Fundamentals of Epidemiology
- Biostatistical Methods I
- Issues in Environmental and Occupational Health
- Public Health Management
- Fundamentals of Social and Behavioral Science
- Ethics in Public Health: Professional Practice and Policy
- Field Experience: Public Health Practice
- Master's Project: Public Health Practice



Eligibility

The program is aimed at professionals with significant work experience in the area of health or human services, and who have an advanced degree, such as an M.D., D.V.M., D.D.S., Pharm.D., M.S., or Ph.D.

Students who successfully complete Course I, II, and III of the ISP Executive Healthcare Study Program are also eligible to apply for the Executive Program in Public Health Practice. For information on eligibility for ISP, please visit <http://www.isp.sph.umn.edu>.
