

EXECUTIVE PUBLIC HEALTH ADMINISTRATION & POLICY (MPH)

The Executive Public Health Administration & Policy cohort model curriculum emphasizes the skills necessary for population-focused administration, policy development, and evidence-based public health. Students take a total of 42 credits.

Executive Public Health Administration & Policy MPH students complete their MPH degree in as little as 25 months, with a combination of online (35 credits) and five on-campus sessions (7 credits).

Students who have not previously worked in government- or community-based population health organizations do a field experience. All students complete a master's project in an area of interest related to public health. Students are encouraged to choose projects in their communities or at their place of employment.

Students choose electives from UMN online offerings, courses at the SPH Public Health Institute, and other options to suit their individual learning goals.
