


"A system in which public policies, institutional practices, cultural representations and other norms work in various, often reinforcing ways to perpetuate racial group inequity."




- NorthPoint came into existence as Pilot City in response to structural racism
- Provides medical, dental, mental health and social services to over 35,000 people annually.
- Partnership with Hennepin County
- Over 93% of patients/clients are people of color
- 99% of people are low income; 34% uninsured
