

## GLOBAL HEALTH MINOR

The Global Health Minor provides students with knowledge, skills, and attitudes to address health issues that transcend national boundaries and prepare them to develop and implement solutions to health problems that require global cooperation. Students take public health courses that focus on the population health skills necessary to promote the health, well-being, and safety of global and local levels. There are 7 required credits for Masters students. Doctoral students will select electives in consultation with advisor and Director of Graduate Studies to complete the 12 credit minimum. All minor coursework must be taken A – F. Graduate credits can be applied toward either the major or the minor/other requirement, but not both.
