

GLOBAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE

The Global Health Certificate is designed for students who have a strong interest in global health, who have a desire to understand cultures, and who may want to experience first-hand a global applied practice experience which could prepare them for work in a global setting. Students must complete minimum 15 credits. Courses not on this list of electives may be considered upon petition and approval of the Program Director. Students must take the required courses for A/F and achieve a grade of B- or above. Electives can be taken either A/F or S/N. Students must achieve a grade of B- or above in elective courses taken A/F.
