With an MPH you'll be ready to shape policy and protect health in a variety of communities such as children, elderly, disadvantaged, rural, urban, and more.

Choose Your Path: MPH Programs at SPH

Community Health Promotion: Design, deliver, and evaluate social and behavioral programs and policies to advance health equity.

Environmental Health: Explore how air, water, animal, food, and work environments impact health and how to protect people.

Epidemiology: Study disease patterns, analyze data, and uncover the causes behind health trends to improve public health.

Maternal & Child Health: Advance health equity for women, children, birthing people, and families through advocacy, care, and research.

Public Health Administration & Policy: Shape policy and manage health organizations to create systems that better serve entire communities and populations.

Public Health Data Science: Use coding, statistics, and machine learning to drive evidence-based solutions to public health challenges.

Public Health Practice: For working professionals (physicians, pharmacist, dentists, nurses, veterinarians), this flexible program supports your training to lead population health efforts.

Public Health Nutrition: Tackle nutrition-related health disparities and promote food justice through science, policy, and community engagement.
